continue to parent
through cohabitation and
visitation, providing

caretaking, financial, and other in-kind support. This volume captures the meaning and practice of black fatherhood in its many manifestations, exploring two-parent families, cohabitation, single custodial fathering, stepfathering, noncustodial visitation, and parenting by extended family members and friends. This memoir began both as a journal to record his memories for family and friends, and as therapy: Corlew flew many missions during the war's bloodiest year, in addition to enduring enemy mortar and rocket attacks and jungle survival, and his VA counselor encouraged him to record his memories. Engaging, frank, and full of action, it describes Corlew's many combat experiences, the emotional effects that he suffered, and how his faith helped him get through it.
